Private scholarships continue to be the best form to pay for college tuition and other expenses. Here are some additional online databases with scholarships that don't require proof of citizenship to help pay for college. The more scholarships you apply to, the greater your chances are to be awarded a scholarship.

### **Think of it as an investment in yourself:**

If a scholarship is worth a \$1,000 and you spend 10 hours in submitting a scholarship application, it can result in \$100 per hour payment once you're granted the scholarship. Most scholarships have similar prompts so you can use the same essay and re-edit it for each application you submit.
